

ORDINANCE NO. 23

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF EXTERNAL HEATING SYSTEMS
AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

The City of Tower ordains as follows:

Section 1. External heating systems using fossil fuels or other bio-mass material as a source of energy, if constructed in sufficient numbers in the City of Tower, may create a pollution nuisance affecting the public health and welfare and quality of life of the residents of the City of Tower.

Section 2. Use of external heating systems located in a shelter or building other than the residence or standing on its own, is prohibited within the City of Tower.

Section 3. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor as defined by Minnesota State Statute.
