

ORDINANCE NUMBER 10
CITY OF TOWER, MINNESOTA

An Ordinance regulating the use of firearms within the limits of the City of Tower.

The City of Tower ordains:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons within the limits of the City of Tower to aim a gun, pistol, revolver, or other firearm, whether loaded or not, at or toward any human being or to willfully discharge any firearm, air gun, or other weapon or to throw or cause to be propelled any deadly missile in a public place, or in any place where there is any person to be endangered, although no injury actually results.

Section 2. No minor under the age of fourteen (14) years shall handle, or have in his possession or under his control, except while accompanied by or under the immediate charge of his parent or guardian, any firearm, of any kind for hunting, target practice, or any other purpose and it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to aid or knowingly permit any such minor to have such firearms in his possession while unaccompanied by or not under the immediate charge of his parent or guardian.

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$300.00 or imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days or both.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.

Given its first reading on the 12th day of November 1974.

Given its second reading on the 10th day of December 1974.

Moved by Radtke, and supported by Swanson, that the Ordinance be adopted.
