

# **ORDINANCE NUMBER 14**

## **CITY OF TOWER, MINNESOTA**

An Ordinance creating a commission to be known as the City of Tower Tourism Development and Administration Commission and establishing its powers and duties.

The City of Tower does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Name. That there be and is hereby created a commission to be entitled "City of Tower Tourism Development and Administration Commission".

Section 2. PURPOSE. The purpose of said Commission is to promote the development of tourism by encouraging the visiting of the City of Tower by tourists and travelers and other persons, the development of attractions and facilities of whatever nature and kind reasonably necessary and in accordance with the powers possessed by the City of Tower to accomplish the above objectives and to administer and engage in the acquisition, construction, and administration and management of any and all tourist attractions and related facilities; including but not limiting to marinas, campgrounds, beaches, and golf course. That the said commission shall bear and have the complete responsibility for the management of any and all tourist facilities including any and all day to day operations including but not limited to hiring and discharging of employees, keeping of all necessary and proper records, advertising, and promotion, and any and all functions and duties reasonably necessary to properly operate and maintain any and all tourist attractions and facilities.

Section 3. MEMBERS AND TERMS OF OFFICE. That the said Commission shall be composed of five voting members to be appointed by the City Council from amongst the citizens of the City of Tower, that each member shall serve for a term of two years. In the event of a vacancy on the said Commission, then the City Council shall appoint a successor for the balance of the unfilled term. That there be in addition, two ex-officio members of said Commission who shall be appointed by the Council from its own members which two members shall have no vote in the proceedings of the said Commission and shall be appointed for a term of two years, that for the first Commission there will be three members appointed for one year, three members appointed for two years, and one member appointed for three years with the successors to such members to be appointed for a regular two year term.

Section 4. PROCEDURE. That the Commission shall choose its own officers and shall adopt such rules and regulations to conduct its proceedings that the said Commission shall in its sole discretion deem advisable.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and legal publication.
