

ORDINANCE NUMBER 18

CITY OF TOWER, MINNESOTA

An Ordinance prohibiting open burning upon public grounds, regulating open burning and providing a penalty for the violation thereof.

The City of Tower ordains as follows:

Section 1. OPEN BURNING ON PUBLIC GROUNDS. It shall be unlawful to conduct open burning within any part of the City in which such burning is not absolutely prohibited by the provision of Section 1 hereof, except in compliance with the following regulations.

- A. Such burning shall require a city burning permit and shall be in accordance to times, rules, regulations, and restrictions therein. Said permit may only be issued by duly commissioned City authority.
- B. There shall be no open burning within 15 feet from any building or less than 10 feet from any side lot line, or on the front of any lot or plot.
- C. Said permit shall have times of start extinguishment noted.
- D. All sites must be familiar to or inspected by duly commissioned City authority.
- E. All permits issued after a fire has been started will have a nominal fee attached.
- F. All open fires require a permit.

This ordinance repeals Ordinance #48.

Introduced by Alderman Mollers and given its first reading on June 12, 1995.

Given second reading on July 10, 1995 by Alderman Mollers.

Moved by Alderman Mollers supported by Mayor Lamppa that this ordinance be adopted.
