

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1-A
CITY OF TOWER, MINNESOTA

An Ordinance relating to the control and regulation of the control of the water system in the City of Tower and amending sections four and seven of the city of Tower Ordinance entitled and ordinance to control and regulate the water system in the City of Tower.

The City Council of the City of Tower ordains:

Section 1. Section 4 of Ordinance One is amended to read as follows: The tapping of the main line for an applicant shall be done by the city and for which the applicant shall pay such reasonable amount as is fixed from time to time by resolution of the City Council.

Section 2. Section 7 of Ordinance One is amended to read as follows: All service pipes shall be lead, copper, or brass and shall be laid seven feet below the established grade or as low as the street mains.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective on its passage, adoption and publication.

Introduced by Alderman Bystrom and given its first reading on May 15, 1956. Given its second reading on May 29, 1956.

Moved by Alderman Carlon supported by Alderman Bystrom that the ordinance be adopted.
