

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 1-B**  
**CITY OF TOWER, MINNESOTA**

An ordinance relating to water rates collection of water charges and to the water system of the city of tower, amending section xviii of ordinance no. 1 as amended by section 1 of ordinance no. 1-a and repealing ordinance no. 1-a:

The City Council of the City of Tower ordains as follows:

Section XVIII of Ordinance No. 1 as amended by Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1-A of the City of Tower is again amended to be and read as follows:

Section 1. RATES AND PAYMENTS: Rates for water service shall be fixed from time to time by motion or resolution of the City Council to be payable periodically upon receipt of a bill which shall be furnished prior to the 25<sup>th</sup> day of the month following the end of said period and shall cover said period. The period of each bill shall be monthly, quarterly , or such other period as from time to time shall be determined by motion or resolution of the City Council. If a bill is unpaid on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of the month following the period in which service was rendered a 10% penalty will be added. If any charge for water service remains unpaid for a period of 90 days after due, service will be discontinued and a charge as provided in Section XV of Ordinance No. 1 shall be made for re-connection.

Section II. Ordinance No. 1-A of the City of Tower is hereby repealed.

Section III. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after January 1, 1957.

Introduced by Alderman Hendrickson and given first reading November 13, 1956. Given second reading December 11, 1956.

Moved by Alderman Bystrom supported by Alderman Axelson that the ordinance be adopted.
