

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1-C
CITY OF TOWER, MINNESOTA

An ordinance relating to the control and regulation of the water system of the city of tower.

Amending Section 9 of Ordinance No. 1

The City Council of the City of Tower ordains as follows:

Section 9 of Ordinance No. 1 of the City of Tower is amended to be and read as follows:

The cost of original installation of all plumbing between the City main and any service devises maintained by the consumer and all extensions hereafter made to such service pipe as well as all repairs and maintenance of said lines connecting with the City main shall be borne entirely by the consumer, although such service pipe and devises shall at all reasonable times be subject to inspection by duty authorized officials of the Water Department. Any repairs found to be necessary by such officials shall be made promptly by the consumer or the City may do so itself and charge the consumer for the cost of such repairs. In the event of the abandonment of any connection with the City main it shall be the responsibility of the consumer to pay for the disconnecting of said abandoned line.

Introduced by Alderman Hendrickson and given its first reading June 4, 1957.

Given its second reading June 11, 1957.

Moved by Alderman Carlon, supported by Alderman Bystrom that the Ordinance be adopted.
