

# ORDINANCE NUMBER 40A

## CITY OF TOWER, MINNESOTA

An ordinance amending an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance licensing and regulating the sale of non-intoxicating malt liquors within the corporate limits of the City of Tower."

The City Tower of Ordains:

Section 1. That Section 15 of Ordinance Number 27 be amended and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 15. No sale of non-intoxicating liquor shall be made on any Sunday between the hours of 1:00AM and 12:00 Noon nor between the hours of 1:00AM and 8:00PM on any election day, nor between the hours of 1:00AM and 8:00AM on any weekday Monday through Saturday inclusive.

Section 2. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or imprisonment for not more than 90 days.

Section 3. If any part, section, clause, or paragraph of this ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional the validity of any of the other parts of this ordinance not invalid shall not be affected.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in effect on its passage, adoption, and publication.

Introduced by Alderman Gornick and given first reading on November 15, 1949.

Given second reading November 29, 1949.

Moved by Alderman Gornick, supported by Alderman Wilson that the ordinance be adopted.

Adopted November 29, 1949 by the following vote:
