

# ORDINANCE NUMBER 42

## CITY OF TOWER, MINNESOTA

An ordinance regulating lawful charitable gambling activities, the distribution of funds thereof and filing of reports in the City of Tower.

The City of Tower ordains:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Tower, under the authority of Minnesota Statutes from Laws 1994 Chapter 633, Article 5, Section 96; ordains that any licensed organization conducting lawful charitable gambling within the City of Tower shall devote a minimum of 90 percent of its lawful purposes expenditures within the City of Tower Trade Area. Said trade area shall be defined as the area being within the boundaries of the City of Tower, Township of Breitung, Township of Kugler, Township of Greenwood, Township of Vermilion Lake, and the Township of Eagles Nest.

Section 2. Each licensed organization which conducts lawful charitable gambling activities within the City of Tower shall file with the City Clerk/ Treasurer, on a monthly basis:

- A. A report specifying the amount of expenditures for lawful purposes within the Tower Trade Area;
- B. A monthly financial statement.

Section 3. The City reserves the right as granted by State Law to require that the books and reports which licensed organizations conducting lawful charitable gambling are required to keep and submit to the State, be also made available to designated City Officials from time to time for the City to review, for the purpose of determining whether the organization is in compliance with this ordinance.

Section 4. Failure to make timely reports and violation of any part of this ordinance shall be considered grounds for the City to refuse to approve the granting or renewal of the gambling license of the organization which is in violation.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon publication.

Introduced by Alderman Hendrickson and given first reading on August 10, 1994.

Given second reading on September 14, 1994 by Aldermen Hiltunen.

Motion by Hendrickson supported by Hiltunen to adopt and publish said ordinance.
