

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 47**  
**CITY OF TOWER, MINNESOTA**

An ordinance regulating coasting and sliding upon the streets, alleys, and sidewalks in the corporate limits of the City of Tower.

The City of Tower ordains:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to coast or slide with a sled, toboggan, wagon, or any other vehicle upon any street, alley, or sidewalk in the corporate limits of the City of Tower except those so designated as coasting or sliding streets or alleys by the City Council and then only when such streets and alleys are properly marked at all intersections by warning signs erected at the order of the City Council and which shall read as follows:

"Stop-Children Coasting"

On Streets and alleys so designated all coasting or sliding shall be done in a careful and orderly manner and with due regard to the safety of others.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to drive or cause to be driven any vehicle and to enter upon any street on which coasting is permitted by the City Council as specified in Section 1 without first coming to a full stop before entering any such street.

Section 3. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or imprisonment for not more than 90 days.

Section 4. If any part, section, clause, or paragraph of this ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the validity of any of the other parts of this ordinance not invalid shall not be affected.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in effect on its passage, adoption, and publication.

Introduced by Alderman Swanson and given first reading on August 15, 1944.

Given second reading September 12, 1944.

Moved by Alderman Swanson, supported by Alderman Kitto that the ordinance be adopted.

Ayes: Aldermen Swanson, Kitto, Gornick, and Shafer and Mayor Winchell.

Nays: None.
