

# ORDINANCE NUMBER 49

## CITY OF TOWER, MINNESOTA

The Tower City Council, in order to preserve the peace, safety, and welfare of the public within the city, ordains that the following ordinance be immediately adopted.

An ordinance prohibiting children under the age of 18 years from being in or upon the streets, alleys, or public places within the corporate limits of the City of Tower during the designated hours.

The City of Tower ordains:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any boy or girl of the age of 17 years or younger to be abroad upon the streets, alleys, or public grounds for the City of Tower between the hours from 10:00PM and 6:00AM. On Fridays and Saturdays the time will be between 11:00PM and 6:00AM. In the months of June, July, and August, the times will be between 11:00PM and 6:00AM for all days.

Exceptions to this curfew will be:

- A. If the juvenile is accompanied by his parent, guardian, or employer.
- B. If the juvenile is upon some errand by permission or direction of his parent, guardian, or employer, in which case he or she shall not loiter on the way, make undue noise by shouting or yelling or otherwise to disturb the peace and quiet of the City.
- C. If there is a school function which has not been completed at time of the curfew (such as school dances, game, etc.). In this case, the juvenile must not loiter on the way home, make undue noise by shouting or yelling, or otherwise to disturb the peace and quiet of the City.
- D. If the juveniles employment requires him or her to be on the City Streets, alleys, or public places

Section 2. Any person violating any such provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 3. If any part, section, clause, or paragraph of this ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional the validity of any of the parts of this ordinance not invalid shall not be effected.

Adopted: June 12, 1995, as an emergency ordinance granted under the City Charter. This ordinance repeals ordinance 34A.
