

# ORDINANCE NUMBER 55B

## CITY OF TOWER, MINNESOTA

An ordinance to provide for the vacation of that part of birch street which lies between the southerly line of North Third Street and the northerly line of North Second Street in the plat of Tower and in the City of Tower.

The City of Tower ordains:

Section 1. All that part of Birch Street in the City of Tower lying between the Southerly line of North Third Street and the northerly line of North Second Street in the plat of Tower in Saint Louis County, Minnesota, is hereby vacated and discontinued as a public street and way, provided, however that the City of Tower, for itself and its successors and assigns, hereby reserves a perpetual easement therein to maintain the sewer line now therein, and to lay, re-lay, and maintain said sewer line. The portion of Birch Street so vacated is shown as partly colored on the plat of proposed vacation in 1955 of part of Birch Street in the plat of Tower, which plat is hereto attached and which accompanied the Petition for Vacation.

Section 2. It is hereby declared that this ordinance is adopted, pursuant to proceedings duly and regularly had in compliance with law and with the Charter and ordinances of the City of Tower.
