

ORDINANCE NUMBER 59A

CITY OF TOWER, MINNESOTA

An ordinance amending an ordinance entitled "An ordinance regulating the licensing of transient merchants, hawkers, peddlers, and solicitors."

The City of Tower Ordains:

Section 1. That an ordinance numbered six (6) entitled "An ordinance regulating the licensing of transient merchants, hawkers, peddlers, and solicitors," be and the same is hereby amended as hereinafter set forth.

Section 2. That sub-section (h) of Section 9 of said ordinance reading as follows, "Sales by an honorably discharged ex-soldier or ex-sailor of the United States." Be and the same is hereby stricken and deleted from said ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval, and publication.
