

# ORDINANCE NUMBER 60

## CITY OF TOWER, MINNESOTA

An ordinance regulating the removal of snow from the sidewalks within the City of Tower.

The City of Tower ordains:

Section 1. SNOW TO BE REMOVED. All occupants of tenements or lots located within the City of Tower, and all owners of vacant and unoccupied tenements or jobs located within the City of Tower, shall remove snow from sidewalks abutting on or adjacent to said tenements or lots are herein provided.

Section 2. TIME OF SNOW REMOVAL. Snow Shall be removed by occupants or owners of tenements or lots within the City of Tower, from sidewalks adjacent to said tenements or lots within twelve hours after the snow has ceased falling.

Section 3. ASSESSMENT. In case any such occupant or owner shall fail or refuse to remove snow on sidewalks abutting tenements or lots occupied or owned by them, the City Council shall cause said work to be done; and on the refusal or failure of said owners or occupants to pay the cost of said snow removal, the costs thereof shall be assessed against the real property abutting upon said sidewalks, which assessment shall be entered and collected in accordance with the provisions of the City Charter.

Section 4. PENALTY. Any person violating the foregoing provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than ninety (90) days. The foregoing penalty shall not relieve him from paying the cost of removing said snow as hereinbefore provided.

Section 5. EFFECT. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval, and publication.

Introduced by Alderman Bruno, supported by Alderman Thomas and given first reading December 12, 1941.
