

# ORDINANCE NUMBER 7

## CITY OF TOWER, MINNESOTA

An ordinance adopting the Minnesota Highway Code and repealing ordinance number 21 or any other ordinance inconsistent herewith.

Section 1. Adoption of Traffic Code - The City of Tower ordains that the Minnesota Highway Code (Chapter 169, Minnesota Statutes Annotated) as supplemented by amended, is hereby adopted by the City of Tower, except for such provisions hereof as are inconsistent with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Tower, and except such provisions thereof as are inapplicable to a City of the fourth class.

Section 2. If any paragraph, clause, section, or portion of this Ordinance shall be declared void or unconstitutional, it shall not affect the balance of the Ordinance which may be legally applicable.

Section 3. Effect - This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption, approval, and publication.

Section 4. Repeal - Ordinance Number 21 of the City of Tower, entitled an Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Streets of the City of Tower, and providing a penalty for violation thereof, is hereby repealed.
