

ORDINANCE NUMBER 9

CITY OF TOWER, MINNESOTA

An ordinance regulating the use of public streets and alleys in the City of Tower prohibiting the obstruction of streets and alleys and providing a penalty for violation hereof.

The City of Tower ordains:

Section 1. **PARKING ON STREETS AND ALLEYS.** No person shall park or permit to be parked any vehicle unattended on any street or alley in the City of Tower for a period longer than forty eight (48) hours at any one time.

Section 2. **OBSTRUCTION IN STREETS AND ALLEYS.** It shall be unlawful for any person to place any obstructions to traffic on any streets or alleys in the City of Tower except such as are authorized by the City Council, the ordinances of the City of Tower, or the statutes of the State of Minnesota.

Section 3. **REMOVAL OF VEHICLES OR OBSTRUCTIONS.** The Chief of Police, any police officer of the City of Tower, or any city employee engaged in any public work on the streets or alleys of the City requiring the removal of vehicles or other obstructions from any streets or alleys within the City of Tower is hereby authorized to move such obstructions or vehicles as may be necessitated by any public work or may require the owner of any such obstruction or vehicle to forthwith move any such obstruction or vehicle obstructing or preventing the continuance of any such public work in the streets or alleys of the City of Tower.

Section 4. **EXCEPTIONS.** There is excepted from application of the above provisions any streets in the City of Tower that are now or that may later come under the jurisdiction of the State Commissioner of Highways.

Section 5. **PENALTY.** Any person or persons violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or imprisonment of not more than 90 days.

Section 6. If any part, section, paragraph, or clause of this ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional the validity of any of the other parts of this ordinance not invalid shall not be affected.

Section 7. This ordinance shall be in effect on its passage, adoption, and publication.
