

ORDINANCE NUMBER 39D

CITY OF TOWER, MINNESOTA

An ordinance amending Ordinance # 39, Ordinance #39A, and Ordinance # 40.

The City of Tower Ordains:

Ordinance # 39, Section 5, Part A "Fees" is amended to state that the cost of all liquor licenses are established by the Tower City Council on an annual basis at their annual reorganization meeting. A copy of the license rates is on file at the Tower City Clerk's Office and available for public viewing at any time.

Ordinance # 39, Section 6, Part A "Preliminary Investigation" is amended to reflect that the City of Tower does not charge a one hundred fifty dollar (\$150.00) application investigation fee.

Ordinance #39, Section 7, Part C " Distance from school or church" is amended to state that the commercial zoned district is defined in City of Tower Ordinance #82 dated 1997.

Ordinance #39 Section 9, Part B "Consumption in Public Places" shall be amended to say that no person shall serve or consume intoxicating beverages on a public highway, public park, or other public place. Any individual or group wishing to provide intoxicating liquor to be sold, served, and/or consumed on public highway, public park, or other public place shall secure expressed written permission of the Tower City Council. No intoxicating liquor can be sold on a public highway, public park, or other public place unless the selling agent has obtained the proper liquor sale licensing.

Ordinance # 39 shall be amended to include Section 9, Part C stating that intoxicating liquor can be served and consumed at private events (events by invitation only) held on the premises of the Tower Civic Center. The sale of intoxicating liquor on the premises of the Tower Civic Center without a valid liquor or caterer's license is forbidden.

Ordinance #39A Section 3, Part G shall be amended to say that the fee for obtaining a Sunday Liquor License is set by the State of Minnesota and a copy of the current rate is on file at the Tower City Clerk's Office.

Ordinance #40, Section 3 is amended to say that the cost of all liquor licenses are established by the Tower City Council on an annual basis at the annual reorganization meeting. A copy of the license rates is on file at the Tower City Clerk's Office.
