The regular meeting of the Tower City Council was called to order by Mayor Josh Carlson.

A motion was made by Dougherty and supported by Hiltunen to accept the quote and award the North Second Street Sidewalk improvement to Broten Construction. Councilors Hiltunen and Dougherty assented. Mayor Carlson assented. Councilor Broten abstained. The motion carried.

A motion as made by Hiltunen and supported by Broten to partner with the Tower Women's Civic Improvement Club to improve the landscaping around the Tower Fire / Ambulance Hall and Tower Civic Center with the City Contributing \$1,000.00 from the Ambulance Budget, \$1,000.00 from the Fire Department Budget, and \$1,000.00 from the Civic Center Budget. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Dougherty and supported by Broten to resolve that winter clothing; and
Whereas, currently there is a campaign called "Change The Range" which encourages offering a place for donating and receiving winter clothing across Iron Range Communities; and
Whereas, The Tower City Council supports this campaign; and
Whereas, the Tower City Council would like to offer the Tower City Hall as an open public area where citizens can donate or receive winter clothing; and
Now therefore be it resolved the City Council of the City of Tower supports the Change the Range Campaign, is offering its City Hall as a donation site, and does hereby adopt this resolution. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Broten and supported by Dougherty to table the AFSCME Local 1490 Longevity Compensation negotiations until December 3, 2015. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Hiltunen and supported by Broten to adjourn. Time out was 7:58PM.
