The regular meeting of the Tower City Council was called to order by Mayor Josh Carlson.

A motion was made by Dougherty and supported by Matich to accept the agenda as amended with the deletion of 6.1 TEDA Manufacturing Building. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Carlson and supported by Matich to give Dave Durrant an extension in time until June 22, 2018 to resolve the blight issues at his properties and failure to resolve the issues by June 22, 2018 will result in a civic citation for each day the violation exists. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Carlson and supported by Matich to hire Amptek Electric to complete additional repairs necessary on the Hoodoo Point Sewer Upgrade Project. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Matich and supported by Dougherty to authorize the Lake Vermilion Events Board to close a ½ block section of Poplar Street from Main Street South to the alley for a period of noon to midnight on June 7, 2018. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Fitton and supported by Matich to issue approval to KC Companies to sell and transfer the title to Vermilion Senior Living LLC. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Matich and supported by Fitton to authorize the City Clerk Treasurer to apply for IRRRB Commercial Demolition Funds on behalf of the Tower Economic Development Authority and the Lake Vermilion Cultural Center. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Fitton and supported by Matich to resolve that Whereas, The authorizing authority of the City of Tower approves the application on behalf of the Tower Economic Development Authority and acceptance of grants from the Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation Board (IRRRB) for the demolition of the exterior surfaces of the Lake Vermilion Cultural Center within the City of Tower; and Whereas, The authorizing authority hereby agrees to accept funding for the underlying project if approved by the IRRRB; NOW, THEREFOER BE IT RESOLVED, that the authorizing authority of the City of Tower does hereby adopt this resolution. The motion carried unanimously.
