The regular meeting of the Tower City Council was called to order by Mayor Josh Carlson.

A motion was made by Hiltunen and supported by Dougherty to approve the minutes of the previous meetings. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Broten and supported by Hiltunen to accept the agenda as amended with the striking of the 2016 Budget and the addition of Permission for D'Erricks to Close Street and Extend Patio. The motion carried unanimously.

Public Input: No public input was given.

A motion was made by Hiltunen and supported by Broten to accept the reports from officers as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Dougherty and supported by Hiltunen to accept the reports from Commissions and Committees as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Hiltunen and supported by Dougherty to authorize the Immanuel Lutheran Church to close one half block of Spruce Street between Main Street and North Second Street for the evening of August 18, 2015. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Dougherty and supported by Broten to accept Erik Thorp's resignation from the Tower Area Ambulance Service. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Dougherty and supported by Broten to accept the IRRRB Funding of \$140,000.00 for the Scenic Rivers Tower Clinic Handicap Entrance Project. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Dougherty and supported by Broten to set the 2016 City of Tower Preliminary Levy at a ten percent increase. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Carlson and supported to Dougherty to hold a Budget study session on September 30th, 2015 at 5:30PM. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Broten and supported by Dougherty to authorize D'Erricks to close a one half section of Birch Street for a customer appreciation event with the stipulations that the Street be reopened by 11PM, the Music must be concluded by 10PM, and there shall be no obstruction of the alley between Main and South Second Streets. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Dougherty and supported by Broten to consider D'Erricks request to expand the patio at the front of the building. Dave Erickson shall complete a set of plans and consult city maintenance staff for their approval before the City Council will give final approval to the request. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Hiltunen and supported by Dougherty to send notice to all Hoodoo Point Campers that no privately own docks or lifts can be erected on the shoreline adjacent to the Hoodoo Point Campground. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Dougherty and supported by Hiltunen to pay all bills. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Dougherty and supported by Broten to adjourn. Time out was 6:23PM.
