The regular meeting of the Tower City Council was called to order by Mayor Josh Carlson.

A motion was made by Anderson and supported by Fitton to accept the agenda as amended with the additions of 6.3 Airport STS Project Bids, 6.6 Como Oil Employee List, and 6.11 Ambulance Snowmobile Trailer Minimum Bid Requirement. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Fitton and supported by Anderson to issue an easement to the City of Tower for the Hoodoo Point Campground main utility line. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Fitton and supported by Dougherty to accept Low Impact Excavators bid for the construction of a holding tank STS system at the airport in the amount of \$33,500.00. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Anderson and supported by Fitton to accept the bid of \$109.9 per gallon from Como Oil & Propane for propane for the 2018-2019 season. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Dougherty and supported by Fitton to include employees that receive a W2 from the City on the employee list supplied to Como. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Dougherty and supported by Anderson to send a letter to the residents of North Second and North Third Streets advising them that parking in the lanes will no longer be tolerated and violators can expect to be tagged and towed. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was Fitton and supported by Dougherty to transfer Hangar # C3 from

Arden Niemi to Tim Harty. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Fitton and supported by Anderson to authorize C W Dirtworks to prepare the site for the new Welcome to Tower sign at a cost not to exceed \$3,000.00. Councilors Anderson and Fitton and Mayor Carlson assented. Councilor Dougherty dissented. The motion carried.
