MAKE A GRANT APPLICATION

FOR THE FEDERAL RECREATIONAL TRAIL PROGRAM
FOR THE PURCHASE OF SNOWMOBILE FOR GROOMING
OF CITY OF TOWER/HOWARD WAGONER SKI TRAILS**

WHEREAS, the City of Tower hosts the Howard Wagoner cross country ski trails within its municipal forest; and

WHEREAS, the trails are maintained for public use by the Wagoner Trails Club; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tower supports the grant application made to the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources for the Federal Recreational Trail Program. This grant application is made to request the purchase of a snowmobile for grooming the ski trails; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tower has secured the twenty-five (25) percent grant match requirement from the Wagoner Trails Club activities and allocations; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TOWER, MINNESOTA if the City of Tower is awarded a grant by the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources, the City of Tower agrees to accept the grant award, and may enter into an agreement with the State of Minnesota for the above referenced project. The City of Tower will comply with all applicable laws, environmental requirements and regulations as stated in the grant agreement; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the applicant has read the Conflict of Interest Policy contained in the Trail Program Grant Manual and certifies it will report any actual, potential, perceived, or organizational conflicts of interest upon discovery to the state related to the application or grant award.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City Council of the City of Tower names the fiscal agent for the City of Tower for this project as:
